New Business:

(1) Supervisor: Don Desrochers stated that he did not have any items to be discussed.

(2) Town Clerk: Deborah Tyler read aloud her monthly report.

(3) Justice Clerk: Bobbi Sparling furnished the Board with a copy of her monthly report.

(4) Fire Department: Nate Tormey reported that things have been slow, thankfully.

(5) Councilperson Perry questioned if the funds in the Wayne Cemetery account could be invested. Don Desrochers explained that those funds are frozen and cannot be touched.

(6) Councilperson Grimmke reported that she has been in contact with the Schuyler Co. Highway Superintendent and he is working on accommodating us the sign requests she made.

She also stated that she is still researching fence policies that other communities have in place. With that CEO, Harold Russell added that there are several other issues that need to be included such as parcel size for structures and multiple structures on the same lot.

He said that some municipalities have Land Use Policies in place covering these type of issues which would enable him to be able to enforce them.

Legislator Mark Rondinaro added that Town may be able to receive funds from the State to help hire counsel when writing a Land Use Policy.

(7) Code Enforcement: Harold Russell read aloud his monthly report.

He also said that he would like to see a Rental Inspection Law so that landlords would have to have rental properties inspected before renting and when vacated.

(8) Highway Superintendent: Not present.

(9) Planning Board: Rory Miller reported that they did not have a November meeting because they did not have a quorum.

(10) County Legislator: Mark Rondinaro reported that October sales tax is down from the same time last year.

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(11) Lakes Association: Cartha Conklin stated that they do not meet in the winter.
