WHEREAS, on November 10, 2020 the Town of Tyrone held a Public Hearing on the General Fund, Highway Fund, Tyrone Fire Protection District and Wayne Fire Protection District proposed budgets for the year 2021, and

WHEREAS, there were no changes made to the preliminary budget presented at the Public Hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Tyrone hereby adopts the Preliminary Budgets, presented as follows as the Final Budget for the year 2021.

GENERAL FUND BUDGET: With total appropriations & revenues of \$303,101.00 with total revenues from Real Property Taxes of \$93,914.00.

HIGHWAY FUND BUDGET: With total appropriations & revenues of \$880,613.00 with total revenues from Real Property taxes of \$548,278.00.

TYRONE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT: With total appropriations & revenues of \$154,000.00 with total revenues from Real Property Taxes of \$154,000.00.

WAYNE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT: With total appropriations & revenues of \$24,883.00 with total revenues from Real Property Taxes of \$24,883.00.
